Paramount Reimbursement Incentive Available

Paramount offers an additional reimbursement for physicians who follow up with Paramount patients prescribed ADD/ADHD medications. Providers will receive an additional reimbursement up to \$40 per patient per calendar year for a follow-up call made during the maintenance phase (days 31-300) of ADD/ADHD medication therapy. Benefits of Credentialing Allied Health Professionals with PFK

Credentialing allied health professionals (APRN's and PA's) with PFK can save you time. One application to PFK will credential the applicant with all five of Ohio's Medicaid managed care plans.

Attribution Model

For purposes of the PFK Physician Incentive Program, services provided by an allied health professional will be credited to the physician to whom the patient is assigned or attributed. Refer to the attached PFK Attribution Model diagram for more details.

2016 Flu Vaccine

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Advisory Committee has recommended against using the Flu-Mist Quadrivalent during this coming flu season. Recent data shows that the vaccine was only 46% effective in 2015-16, compared to the flu shot's 65% efficacy.. AstraZeneca is accepting returns at no cost to the providers.

Nationwide Children's Hospital – CPR Training

Nationwide Children's Hospital offers Basic Life Support (BLS) classes off site for a cost of \$75 per person. Trainers are available to provide training at your office for up to 12 staff members per session. NCH will loan books in advance to be returned the day of training.
