2015 Non-Compliant Lists

Recently, non-compliant lists were disseminated with the physician incentive reconciliation payment. These lists capture patients that did not complete a well visit in 2015. If patients are listed in error, please submit the attached form along with an accompanying explanation of benefits. Remember that if a patient attributed to your practice receives well-care outside of your office, you will still receive credit for those services.

Medicaid Patient Information Sheets

Babies are often initially enrolled with a health plan as “Baby Boy Smith” or “Baby Girl Jones”. It is imperative that the member’s name is updated by his/her first birthday or payors may deny reimbursement to providers. Please instruct parents to contact the appropriate managed Medicaid plan directly to update member information.

Molina ID Cards

Member ID cards list each member’s designated PCP. Since members have the option of seeing any provider, the ID card may list the incorrect provider. Providers should encourage members to update their ID cards online at MyMolina.com or by calling Member Services at (800) 642-4168.

Subsidies for Electronic Medical Records

Is your practice still looking for an EMR system? Funds available through the federal Meaningful Use program will no longer be available after 2016. However, Nationwide Children’s Hospital will continue to offer 70% discounts on one-time implementation and installation fees for practices interested in using eClinical Works.
