## What is ECHO Autism?

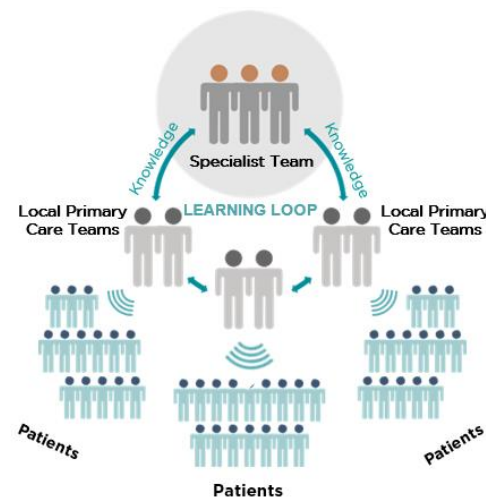
ECHO Autism bridges the care gap between autism specialists, community health care providers and children with autism. Participants will get specific case guidance on children at risk for or diagnosed with autism while learning more about common medical concerns and comorbid conditions in children with autism.



## How Project ECHO works:

ECHO Autism meets virtually on a weekly or bi-weekly schedule for 12 sessions each lasting 60 minutes. Participants have a chance to discuss pediatric cases for real-time advice from experts and learn about best practices and evidence-based care for:
 

- Screening, diagnosis and treatments
- Common medical concerns and comorbidities
- Successful office visits.
