Lifeline Program Eligibility in Ohio

You are eligible if you receive benefits from any of these programs in Ohio:

- Medicaid
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (Food Stamps or SNAP)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (Section 8)
- Veterans Pension and Survivor's Benefit
- Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance (BIA)
- Tribally Administered Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (Tribal TANF)
- Tribal Head Start (only those households meeting its income qualifying standard)
- Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR)

You may also qualify if your Total Household Income is at or under 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines (see below for income limits):

2 members	\$22,221
3 members	\$28,053
4 members	\$33,885
5 members	\$39,717
6 members	\$45,549
7 members	\$51,381
8 members	\$57,213
For each additional member, add \$5,832 annually	

* Only one Lifeline benefit is available per household, either wireless or landline.

You will have to complete eligibility paperwork to receive services, and all phone providers require annual recertification.
