Billing and Reimbursement

Application of Topical Fluoride Varnish by a Non-Dental Practitioner

- Fluoride varnish application should be reported on a claim using CPT code **99188**.
 - o ICD-10 code **Z29.3** should accompany 99188.
- Payment may be made not more frequently than once per 180 days from tooth eruption to (but not including) the sixth birthday.
- Fluoride varnish can be applied at any visit (i.e., well or sick visit) but cannot be the sole reason for the visit.
- The following practitioners can **order** and **bill** for fluoride varnish:
 - o Physician
 - o Physician Assistant
 - Advanced Practice Registered Nurse
- The following practitioners can **apply** fluoride varnish in addition and under the supervision of the above practitioners:
 - Registered Nurse
 - o Licensed Practical Nurse
 - Medical Assistant
- As of January 1, 2024, fluoride varnish billed under CPT 99188 is reimbursed at \$29.48.

Fluoride varnish billing in the medical office is independent from the dental office.
