### why

#### Choose the pulmonary diagnostic lab at Dayton Children's?

Pulmonary diagnostic services at Dayton Children's provide a variety of tests and procedures to assist in diagnosis and treatment of lung diseases or other impairments.

- Tests are performed by respiratory therapists who are certified pulmonary function technologists experienced in pediatrics to obtain reliable quality test results.
- All tests are interpreted by a member of our pediatric pulmonary staff.
- Study results are available within 72 hours (non-weekends).
- A prescription with the test ordered must include the diagnosis and recent H&P with current medications.
- State on order "pre/post bronchodilator" for ordering CPT code 94060

#### are the most common pulmonary function tests to order?
